Giving False Information		
 Deliberately giving false or misleading Information to the Electoral Commission 	5,000	and/or 1 year
Ballot Paper Offences		
· Marking a ballot paper if you are not a registered voter	1,000	
· Removing unmarked ballot papers from a polling place illegally	5,000 and/or 2 years	
· Putting any ballot paper in a ballot box that has not been lawfully issued to a voter.	5,000	and/or 1 year
Voting Offences		
· More than one person being at a polling booth unless assisting a voter	100	
· Using a camera, phone or electronic device in a polling booth	5,000 and/or 1 year	
· Unlawfully entering a polling booth	10,000 and/or 2 year	
Being in a Polling station without official purpose (i.e. voting) or authorisation	100	
· Impersonates another voter, in order to vote, or an election official	5,000 and/or 1 year	
· Trying to vote more than once	5,000 and/or 1 year	
· Obstructing a voter from casting their vote.	10,000 and/or 2 year

Possessing through unofficial means, or manipulating the voter's list electronically or by other means	5,000 aı	nd/or 1 year
